BECOMING A CHRISTIAN THE BIBLE'S WAY



ecoming a Christian begins with recognising that you are a sinner. Your sin separates you from God – Isaiah 59 vs. 1 – 2, and will not only end in physical death but eternal separation from Jesus Christ your Saviour – Romans 3 vs. 23. You must become a Christian.

Becoming a Christian is a simple process of <u>hearing the gospel</u>, <u>believing it</u>, <u>repenting of your past sins</u>, <u>confessing your faith in Christ</u>, and <u>being immersed</u> <u>in water for the removal of all past sins</u>.

The Bible teaches that in coming to God, <u>you must first be taught the gospel</u> – **John 6 vs. 44 – 45**. You must be taught the divine truth of God's word, learn, and then come to Christ. There will be no angels, dreams or tingling feelings involved in your becoming a Christian.

The bible also teaches that <u>you must have faith in the facts, conditions and promises of the gospel</u> – **Acts 15 vs. 9**. Faith changes your attitude and though faith is important, it alone will not save you. You need to do something else – **James 2 vs. 24**, in order to deal with your sinful condition.

Based on this faith, <u>you must be willing to forsake all past sins, and make a decision to stop practicing sin. The Bible calls this repentance</u> – **Luke 13 vs. 3, Acts 17 vs. 30 – 31.** Repentance changes your action toward sin; it is a death to sin.

<u>You friend, must now confess your faith in Christ</u> and be willing to publicly declare that He is the Son of the Living God – **Romans 10 vs. 9 – 10**.

When you have done this, <u>you must be buried in water for the forgiveness or removal of all past sins</u> – Acts 2 vs. 38, <u>for the washing away of your sins</u> – Acts 22 vs. 16, <u>to identify with Christ</u> – Romans 6 vs. 3 – 4 and <u>to become a saved individual</u> – 1 Peter 3 vs. 21.

Only after you have done this will Christ add you to His church, which He bought with His own blood – Acts 20 vs. 28, Romans 16 vs. 16.
