Introduction

The National Bible Quiz was introduced in 2009 to inspire greater interest in Bible study among young Christians. Throughout the three (3) years of its existence we have been impressed with the interest shown and the extent of the time and study put in, to prepare for the event. We are confident that those who have participated have increased in knowledge of God's word and are the better for it.

As we prepare for 2012 we feel the need to extend the reach of the quiz beyond the teams that prepare to compete to the wider youth groups and congregations from which they originate. To this end, we would like to shift the emphasis from a study of the Question Booklets to actual Bible study. For the upcoming Quiz, a theme will be chosen from which the questions will be taken. A study guide will be provided, that outlines the various areas to be focussed on. The responsibility then falls with the individual congregations to organise themselves to cover the material outlined. It will require much time spent in Bible reading, research and study. The emphasis is being shifted from simply knowing the answers to listed questions to knowledge of the material that comprises the questions.

We are very aware that it is an ambitious undertaking, both for the congregations who will take up the challenge to participate and the organizers as well who will have to create a new pool of questions within the constraints of the theme chosen. We believe though, that for those who take up the challenge and see it through it will indeed be spiritually rewarding. Regardless of what happens on the day of competition the months spent studying and preparing will allow you to own knowledge of the Word of God that will eternally be yours. This knowledge will not be restricted to the competitors but to the entire group involved in the study, which can be any and everyone.

It is our intent to provide the means for interactions among all participants to allow the sharing of the experience, knowledge, and support beyond the borders of your local congregation to the wider community of the local brotherhood. Via the internet, we hope discussions will be ignited about the material being studied. Forums will be provided for questions to be asked and discoveries to be shared; creating what we hope will be an island-wide fellowship in the study of God's word.

We know this will be a challenge. You will be pressed for time with competing interests. If you're not already an ardent student of the Bible, making the transition and sticking to it will require discipline and effort on your part. But doing this must never be seen purely as an effort to prepare for a one day Bible Quiz, but as an opportunity to spend quality time feeding our souls, enriching our minds, and drawing closer to God through His word that He has left as our guide.

Overview

The Theme for 2012 is *The Gospels*. This will require an in-depth study of the first four books of the New Testament - Matthew, Mark, Luke and John, and their accounts of the life and teachings of Jesus Christ.

There will be seven (7) areas of focus from which questions will be drawn for the Quiz competition:

1. People
2. Place
3. Quotations
4. Harmony of The Gospels
5. Parables of Jesus
6. Miracles of Jesus
7. Prophecies of Jesus

This booklet contains a reading plan and charts (as sample outlines) to guide your preparation. Please note carefully:

1. This is only a guide to highlight the areas of focus. It is not exhaustive and will require supplemental material to accomplish a proper study.
2. The charts included are not the only ones that exist. Other charts exist that may have more or less information and may be organised differently. Your research must seek to give you the most comprehensive coverage you can find.
3. The information included was derived from the internet. As with all material derived from the internet, be very careful in your research to guard against information presented that may be skewed to one doctrinal position or another.

We are recommending the following 6-step approach (**4RCS - Read, Record, Research, Review, Compare and Study**) in using the material included:

1. **Read through the Gospels** - Matthew to John. You may use the Forty Days and Forty Nights reading plan (1.1) to get through it. The plan is designed for group study.
2. **Record** - As you read you want to maximise your time, so record as you read. For the categories People, Place and Quotations, it is best to note them as you are reading. Keep a note book handy and create lists for the different categories as you read. This is a preliminary list that will provide easy reference for more in depth research later.

For example you could create a 'People' list as shown in the example below.

As you read through where names are repeated, add the reference beside the name already recorded. Do the same for Place. For Quotations try to identify significant verses or significant things said and record the reference for them.

At the end you should have some comprehensive lists to guide your review and study of these areas.

- Research and Write Questions** - Then begin your research getting as much information about the People, Places and Quotations on your lists. Find out:

People	Place	Quotations
Who is this person?	Where is this place?	Who said it?
Why were they mentioned?	Why was it mentioned?	Where was it said?
What did they do?	What happened there?	Who was it said to?

By the end of this exercise you should be swimming in information. To organize it, write questions with the answers. So instead of writing *Isaac was Abraham's son - Matthew 1:2* write

Matthew traces the genealogy of Christ beginning with whom?	Abraham	Matthew 1:2

By the time you would have completed your study of the Gospels you will have your own study booklet to review for the competition.

- Review:**
 - **The Harmony of the Gospels (1.2)** - The Harmony of the Gospels looks at various events in the life of Christ as recorded by the different Gospel writers. Events will be recorded by one, some or all the writers. Where it is reported by multiple writers, there may be variations in the details given.

Our aim is to familiarize ourselves with the events and the accounts of them. We need to know who recorded which events and who did not. For those who recorded it, note what was said about it.

Again, the best approach would be to record your findings in questions that may be used for review later. For example:

Question	Answer	Reference
Which Gospel Writer recorded the birth of John the Baptist?	Luke	Luke 1:57-80
Which Gospel Writers record genealogies of Christ?	Matthew & Luke	Matthew 1:1-17; Luke 3:23-38
Whose record of the genealogy of Christ mentions Rahab and Ruth?	Matthew	Matthew 1:5

NB: The more detailed your study of the Harmony of the Gospels the easier the preparations of the other sections will be.

- **The Parables of Christ (1.3)** - A parable is a simple story using symbols familiar to the audience to teach a moral or spiritual lesson. All the parables met here would have been previously seen in the Harmony of the Gospels. So in your review here, your focus will be on the details of the parables - where is it recorded, what symbols were used, what they represented, what lesson was being taught, who was the audience, and where Jesus was when He told the parable.

Again, the best approach is to write review questions as you discuss the parables.

- **The Miracles of Christ (1.4)** - Again everything here would have been seen in the Harmony of the Gospels, So in your review here, your focus will be on the details of the miracles - where is it recorded, what was the miracle, where was it done, and who was the beneficiary of it.

Again the best approach is to write review questions as you discuss the miracles.

- **The Messianic Prophecies (1.5)** - In this final section, we are looking at the prophecies about the Messiah that were fulfilled by Jesus Christ and recorded in the Gospels. The format is simple - what was the prophecy, who made it, where is its fulfilment recorded.

Again the best approach is to write review questions as you discuss the prophecies.

5. **Compare** - All the persons in your group should have prepared lists by the end of the reading plan. It is now time to review the information you have collected. Compare the lists to ensure everybody is on the same page and nobody missed anything.

6. **Study for the Quiz** - You have done your studies, you have built your own study booklet of questions and answers, now you study to ensure all the information is straight in your head and you are ready for the quiz.

As you go through this process we encourage you to share with others. We are asking that you email your lists and your questions as you complete the sections, to <http://www.annualyouthretreat.com>. This will go a far way in helping us to prepare questions for the quiz but more importantly it will allow us to share to help us all in our studies. We also hope to have a forum established that you can ask questions, share findings and make comments. If we cannot automate to allow you direct access to post to the website, we will allow the facility via email, where you can email your postings to us and we will post them on your behalf.

Again we emphasize that is just a guide, please feel free to customize it to make it work for you and your group. We know it will be a lot of work but we hope you will take on the challenge. Most importantly we hope you will see it as an opportunity to grow and develop. And, please have FUN!

Notes:

When doing the Bible Reading we suggest that you have a notebook and pen close at hand. As you read make notes to help you prepare for the following areas:

1. People

2. Place
3. Quotations

Make a list for each as you come across them in your reading. For **People**, note names and the passage where the name was mentioned. For **Place**, note the name, passage where it was mentioned and what significant act took place there. For **Quotations**, we are looking for both quotations of what persons said and our ability to quote verses within the Gospels. This will probably be the most challenging section to prepare for as you will have to try to identify significant verses and sayings, to note and memorize.

After completing the reading plan or as you go along you can compare lists with other members of the group. The next challenge is to increase your knowledge of the things you've listed. So for **People** you might need to find out who these people were, what did they do and why they were mentioned. Also you may want to check if their names had significant meanings. For **Places** find out what significant event happened there. For **Quotations** the best approach would be to discuss in your group what significant passages you encounter and decide which should be memorized.
